



## CERTIFICATE IN FRENCH

### CF 1 AWARD NAME

**CF 1.1** The University offers the Certificate in French. Holders of this award are permitted to use the letters Cert French (Open) after their names.

### CF 2 REGISTRATION

**CF 2.1** To register as a student, you must satisfy Student Regulation OU 8. There is no academic entry requirement.

**CF 2.2** To qualify for the award, you must ensure that your credit is linked to it. You can do this as part of the course registration process or make a separate request later.

### CF 3 CREDIT REQUIREMENT

**CF 3.1** To qualify for the award you must obtain 60 credit points by the successful completion of compulsory courses in the certificate profile.

**CF 3.2** The credit for this award must include from Open University or collaborative scheme courses a minimum amount of credit that meets the conditions of Student Regulation OU 3.3; that minimum is 20 points.

### CF 4 CREDIT TRANSFER

**CF 4.1** There is no credit transfer scheme for the certificate.
