



## CERTIFICATE IN GERMAN

### **CG 1 AWARD NAME**

**CG 1.1** The University offers the Certificate in German. Holders of this award are permitted to use the letters Cert German (Open) after their names.

### **CG 2 REGISTRATION**

**CG 2.1** To register as a student, you must satisfy Student Regulation OU 8. There is no academic entry requirement.

**CG 2.2** To qualify for the award, you must ensure that your credit is linked to it. You can do this as part of the course registration process or make a separate request later.

### **CG 3 CREDIT REQUIREMENT**

**CG 3.1** To qualify for the award you must obtain 60 credit points by the successful completion of compulsory courses in the certificate profile.

**CG 3.2** The credit for this award must include from Open University or collaborative scheme courses a minimum amount of credit that meets the conditions of Student Regulation OU 3.3; that minimum is 20 points.

### **CG 4 CREDIT TRANSFER**

**CG 4.1** There is no credit transfer scheme for the certificate.
