CM–HSC 1 QUALIFICATION NAME

CM–HSC 1.1 The University offers the Professional Certificate in Management (Health and Social Care). Holders of this qualification are permitted to use the letters Cert Mgmt (HSC) (Open) after their names.

CM–HSC 2 REGISTRATION

CM–HSC 2.1 To register as a student, you must satisfy Student Regulation OU 8. There is no academic entry requirement.

CM–HSC 2.1 To be awarded the certificate, you must ensure that your credit is linked to it. You can do this as part of the registration process, or make a separate request later.

CM–HSC 3 CREDIT REQUIREMENT

CM–HSC 3.1 To be awarded the qualification, you must obtain 60 credits through the successful completion of the compulsory modules.

CM–HSC 3.2 The credit for this qualification must include from Open University modules or collaborative scheme credit a minimum amount of credit that meets the conditions of Student Regulation OU 3.3; that minimum is 20 credits.

CM–HSC 4 CREDIT TRANSFER

CM–HSC 4.1 There is no credit transfer scheme for the certificate.
