CCS 1 AWARD NAME

CCS 1.1 The University offers the Certificate in Contemporary Science. Holders of this award are permitted to use the letters Cert Cont Sci (Open) after their names.

CCS 2 REGISTRATION

CCS 2.1 To register as a student, you must satisfy Student Regulation OU 8. There is no academic entry requirement.

CCS 2.2 To qualify for the award, you must ensure that your credit is linked to it. You can do this as part of the course registration process or make a separate request later.

CCS 3 CREDIT REQUIREMENT

CCS 3.1 To qualify for the award you must obtain 60 credit points by the successful completion of six of the 10-point courses specified in the certificate profile.

CCS 3.2 The credit for this award must include from Open University or collaborative scheme courses a minimum amount of credit that meets the conditions of Student Regulation OU 3.3; that minimum is 20 points.

CCS 4 CREDIT TRANSFER

CCS 4.1 There is no credit transfer scheme for the certificate.
