GD–ME 1 AWARD NAME

GD–ME 1.1 The University offers the Graduate Diploma in Mathematics Education. Holders of this award are permitted to use the letters Grad Dip (Maths Ed) (Open) after their names.

GD–ME 2 REGISTRATION

GD–ME 2.1 To register as a student, you must satisfy Student Regulation OU 8. There is no academic entry requirement.

GD–ME 2.2 To qualify for the award, you must ensure that your credit is linked to it. You can do this as part of the course registration process or make a separate request later.

GD–ME 3 CREDIT REQUIREMENT

GD–ME 3.1 To qualify for the award, you must obtain 120 credit points by the successful completion of courses from the diploma profile.

GD–ME 3.2 The credit for this award must include from Open University courses a minimum amount of credit that meets the conditions of Student Regulation OU 3.3; that minimum amount is 40 points.

GD–ME 4 CREDIT TRANSFER

GD–ME 4.1 The credit transfer scheme for the Graduate Diploma in Mathematics Education is governed by General Award Regulation GA 6.

GD–ME 4.2 Any award of transferred credit will take the form of full-rate transferred credit.

GD–ME 4.3 The maximum award of transferred credit is 60 points, half the credit requirement of the diploma.
